**Artisan Guidelines**

The Burlington Farmers' Market is pleased to be able to offer artisan booths. Artisans must submit an application form with either a sample or a photograph of each type of artwork they will be selling.

Each artisan is required to declare on his/her application that all items that he/she sells are of his/her own creation and were created or produced in his/her presence and/or under his/her direct and personal supervision. All artwork needs to be pre-approved by the Burlington Farmers' Market before being offered for sale. Creations using environmentally-friendly materials are strongly preferred.

The Burlington Farmers' Market reserves the right to prohibit anyone from selling at the Market or any product being sold at the Market that does not adhere to the guidelines within this document.

The following guidelines apply:

- Burlington Farmers' Market general rules apply to Artisans.
- Artisan tables must be reserved in advance.
- All fine arts products must be original and personally executed or supervised directly by the artist of record. Limited edition prints must be signed by the artist and numbered.
- Responsible vendor must be 18 years of age or older.
- All work must be suitable for family audiences.
- No resale of products is allowed.
- It is the vendor's responsibility for all taxes and licenses.
- Artwork will be displayed at artisan's own risk. The Burlington Farmers' Market is not responsible for damage, loss or theft.
- Acceptable Art Products:
  - All fine craft and art media are accepted including but not limited to: clay, fiber, furniture, glass, jewelry, leather, metal, paper, wood, original painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, fiber art, clothing, accessories, weaving, pottery, carvings, sculpture, woodwork, painting and drawing or other forms of illustration, fresh floral arrangements in which all components are grown by the vendor, dried flower arrangements, and mixed media works. Work must be original and executed or supervised by the accepted artist vendor.
- Unacceptable Art Products:
  - "Kit" or "Assembly Line" craft projects. Use of artificial flowers or greenery. Purchased retail items, mass produced, commercially produced kits, molds or imports.
