**Educational/Entertainment Guidelines**

The Burlington Farmers' Market is pleased to offer opportunities for educational and/or entertainment presentations. Organizations and/or performers must submit an application form with either a sample, clear description or a video of their presentation.

Any organization can apply to attend Burlington Farmers' Market as a community, non-profit or educational organization, or as a performer. We are eager to include performers such as musicians, jugglers, storytellers, etc. We welcome guest organizations and individuals to attend the Market to educate the public on the following subjects:

- Nutrition and food preparation
- Environment
- Health
- Organic gardening, lawn, and plant care
- Sustainable living
- Conservation of natural resources and recycling
- Local history
- Fine arts
- Local government bodies (to educate the public about their functioning)
- Others as approved by Market

We also welcome school groups. However, fundraising from the booth is not allowed. As it is the Market's intention to enhance the Burlington community, all activities/presentations must be family-friendly and appropriate for all ages.

Political activities are not allowed. We cannot provide booth space to candidates campaigning for election, to organizations promoting or refuting ballot questions, or to groups gathering signatures on petitions directed at governing bodies. Guests providing educational resources or entertainment at the Market should refrain from endorsing political positions or candidates.
